SEPTEMBER 2020 – “THE GREEN TRIANGLE” BY RACHEL BROWN HOMARD, BA

1. What was your favorite moment during *The Green Triangle* and why?
2. At the beginning of the book, we see Savannah be brave enough to try and stop the three men from hurting her friend in a dark alley in a bad part of town. Would you have been able to do the same thing in her position?
3. What were your original thoughts on Joe when he saved Savannah’s life twice over the course of a few hours, at first appearing as a homeless man? Did your opinions quickly change as you started reading from his point of view?
4. Joe and Savannah’s relationship hits the ground running, with so much love, danger and excitement developing quickly. What were your thoughts on their relationship? Do you think it’s possible to “fall” for someone that quickly? Why or why not?
5. Savannah’s relationship with her parents changes throughout the book. Did you feel her mother was trying to make a genuine effort to strengthen their relationship by the end of the novel? If you had been in Savannah’s shoes, how would you have acted under their “parenting style”?
6. Through Joe’s mind, we got to see a soldier’s experience with PTSD and memories of war. He carried immense guilt, and never saw himself as deserving of the Medal of Honor nor any other type of praise. Were these pieces of the story difficult for you to read? Have you known someone who returned from deployment with similar thoughts and a like-mentality? How did you try and help to support them through that time?
7. Did you believe Holden was as pure as he was made out to be? When did you notice that something seemed “off” about his story? Do you think he every truly cared for Savannah?
8. Throughout the book, we learn of Savannah’s twin brother Cole who is missing from their lives. Savannah seems positive that he is still alive somewhere. What do you think happened to Cole?
9. While reading the book and before finding out his role with the green triangle, did you think Holden would be better for Savannah than Joe? Why or why not?
10. At the end of the book, it mentions that the author is already working on a sequel to *The Green Triangle*. Is there anything you’d like to see happen in the sequel, or any questions you want answered?
